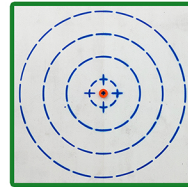


bavarian curling

The game is played between 2 teams with up to 4 people in each team.

Each team should have 4 'Ice Stocks'  each. The idea is for the teams to take turns to slide their 4 stocks down the lane and try to get as close to the "Daube"  as possible to win a round.

At the start of each round the daube is placed in the middle of the target.



Only ice stocks within the target can get points, and the Daube can only be struck and moved within the target area (if it is pushed outside the target area, it is brought back to the middle of the target, or as close as possible).

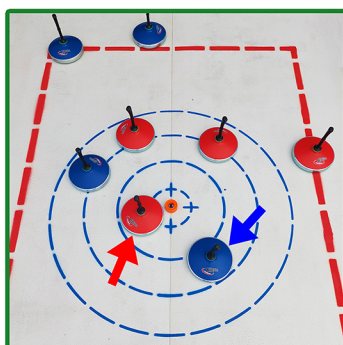
Scoring

After a round of the 8 ice stocks being shot, the closest ice stock to the daube scores 3 points.

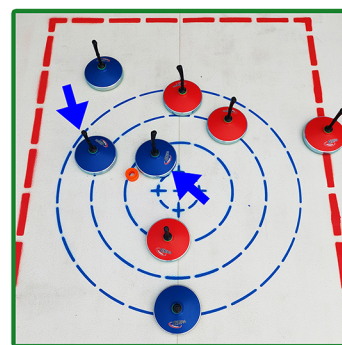
All other ice stocks from the same team within the target area that are closer to the daube than a competitor's ice stocks receive 2 points. The maximum available points per round are 9.

Only the team that wins the round scores any points.

Each game consists of 6 rounds.



Red team wins this round and receives only 3 points, as the blue has the second closest stock.



Blue team wins this round and scores 5 points, as they have 2 stocks closer to the daube.
